

Getting the most out of your gloves... Care and maintenance guide

Did you know?

An estimated 20,000,000 pairs of synthetic work gloves go into landfill in Australia each year! You can help reduce that waste by washing and reusing gloves that are just dirty, not contaminated by oil or chemicals.

Washing instructions

Most gloves can be laundered at 30°C and then air dried to avoid damage!

Removal of gloves

Pull gloves inside out to keep any contaminate contained. If necessary allow the glove to dry naturally.

Checking the fit

Make sure the glove is the correct size. See chart below.

Check for tears

Check for cuts and wear, replace if necessary.

Storage

When not in use, store away from possible contaminates and out of direct sunlight.



Hand Sizing Chart

The right sized glove is important. Follow the steps opposite to find the correct size for you. A full step by step sizing chart is available from uvex, speak to your local representative for more information.

Place the palm of your right hand here with your fingers together.

Place palm here

Line up the inside of your hand just above the thumb joint with the blue line. Read size from chart.
